Chief Peter Van Dorpe worked with the Chicago Fire Department for 33 years, retiring in 2013 as the Director of Training. He then served as the Chief of the Algonquin-Lake in the Hills Fire Protection District through April 1, 2019. He is a member of the Advisory Board for Underwriters Laboratories' Fire Safety Research Institute, and President of the International Society of Fire Service Instructors (ISFSI). In 2012 he delivered the Keynote speech at FDIC.

# **Class Description:**

This is a 1 day class consisting of both lecture and hands-on. Experience meets Science! Since 2006 Chief Van Dorpe has been helping to help bring the science of the Underwriters Laboratories (UL) and National Institute of Standards Technology (NIST) research to the street-level officer and firefighter. At this workshop he will use core concepts from the UL-Fire Safety Research Institute (UL-FSRI) to lead a discussion on developing best practices for mounting an intelligent interior fire attack in a modern fire environment.

At the end of the day, we need to be more "aggressive" than ever before, BUT we must come to a better understanding of what that means and how we can intelligently do so.

Following the discussion, Chief Van Dorpe will lead a hands on demonstration of some of these concepts and tactics utilizing UL-FSRI's water mapping prop. Cost: \$100- (Lunch Provided)
